Sharon Kozicki served as Deputy Governor of the Bank of Canada from 2021 to 2026. She was previously Advisor to the Governor, Managing Director of the Canadian Economic Analysis Department, and Deputy Managing Director of the International Department. She also served on the Board of Directors of the Canadian Deposit Insurance Corporation, was a member of the Committee of the Global Financial System and working groups of the BIS, has served on the Boards of various economic associations, and is on the Statistics Canada Macroeconomic Accounts Advisory Committee.

Ms. Kozicki began her career at the US Federal Reserve Board of Governors in 1992, before moving to the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City, where she progressed to Vice President. She moved to the Bank of Canada in 2006.

Her expertise is in monetary policy, macroeconomics, and macro finance. She led a review of Canada's monetary policy framework and has given presentations on related topics at numerous central banks. She has specialized experience in the development and use of models for forecasting and monetary policy decision-making. Her research has been published in academic journals and as book chapters.

Ms. Kozicki received her PhD in economics from the University of California, San Diego. She also has an MA in economics and a BSc in economics and quantitative methods, and computer science from the University of Toronto.
