■ English proficiency certification

Please submit a TOEFL or IELTS score report. You are welcome to upload a screenshot of your results. However, we would also need the official institution report from ETS. Our institution code for the TOEFL is 0239. Please note-minimum score for TOEFL is 90 points, and minimum score for IELTS is 7.0 Points. In certain cases, you may qualify for a waiver from our language certification requirement.

Applicants can qualify for a waiver if they meet any of the following criteria:

- They are native English speakers.
- They have earned an academic degree with courses taught in English, regardless of their native language.
- They have a minimum of one year of experience studying or working in an English-speaking environment.

☐ Certified/Notarized diploma

Once admitted to the programme, we will need a **certified/notarized hard copy** of the first academic degree (typically Bachelors degree). A copy can be sent directly to the Admissions team or brought in-person.

☐ Reference letters (two in total)

The first letter should be from your current or most recent employer.
