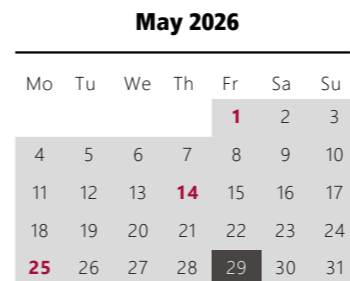
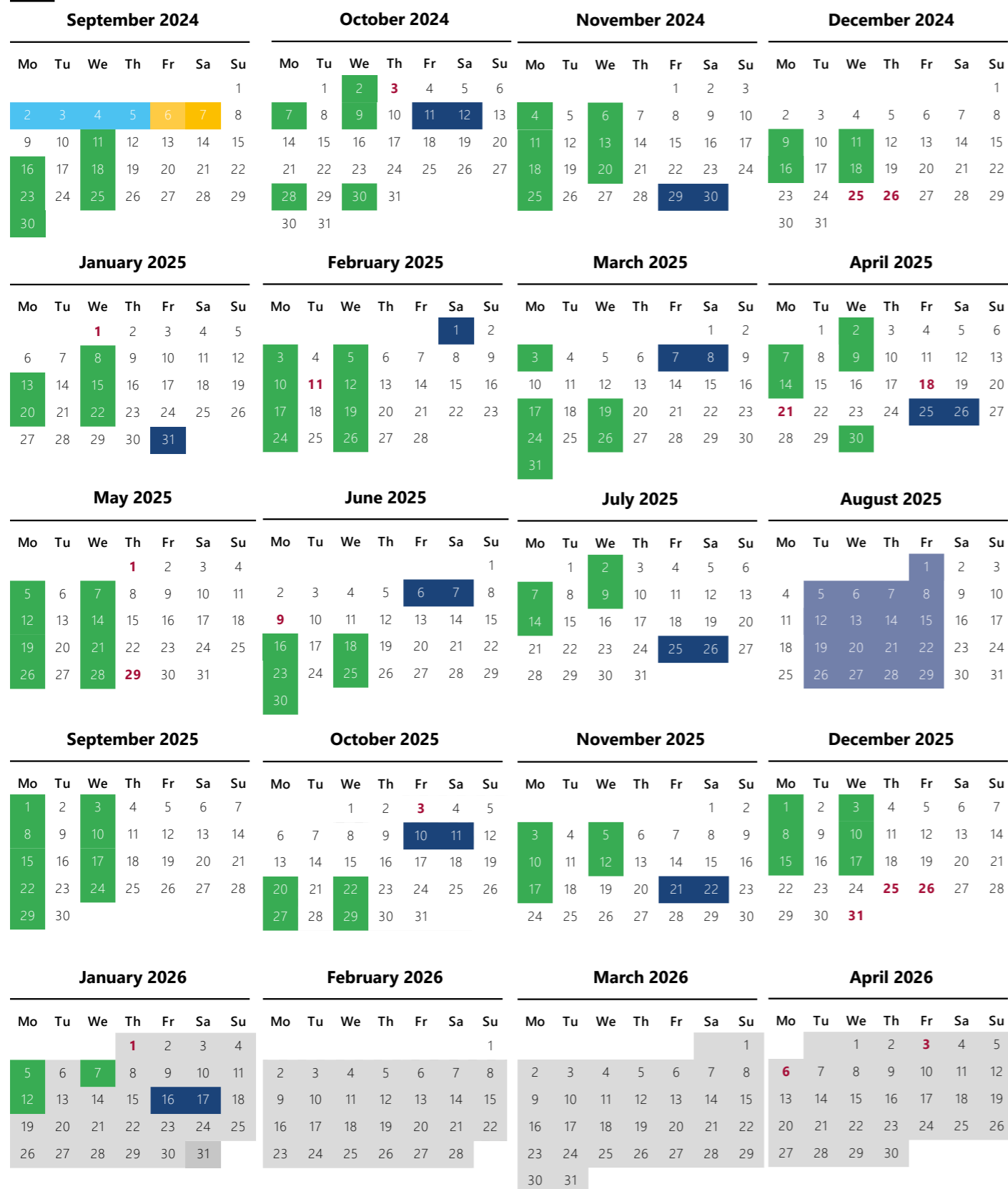


EBI MASTER IN EU BANKING & FINANCIAL REGULATION 2024-2026

Study Model

Students attend class on campus approximately one weekend every other month, while also participating in two to three online evening courses in each module.

The online evening courses are usually scheduled from 05:00 – 08:30 pm CET/CEST (including a break). On-campus courses take place during the day. For students who cannot travel to campus, we offer hybrid options for remote participation. Students have one month of summer break in August. In addition to the eight mandatory core modules, students select two out of four electives offered.

Pre-course: Law

2–5 September 2024
Students without previous experience in law are required to take a law pre-course. The pre-course is online from 05:00 – 08:30 pm CET/CEST. There are no additional costs or fees for the pre-course.

Master Thesis & Internship

Students without previous work experience are required to participate in an internship. This can be done during a month of the student's choosing (within the study period) and completed parallel to the studies. Students who are employed full-time do not need to participate in the internship, as their employment is converted to credits instead.
