## **European Regulatory Reporting Specialist**

Regulatory reporting is a vital and complex process which requires a deep understanding of two things: the demands of regulators and key stakeholders and the needs of the business. This course provides professionals with first class know-how and a practical approach to fulfil these requirements. The end-of-course assessment serves as final documentation of participants' improvement as experts in the field of EU regulatory reporting.

The programme consists of 5 Modulees over 12 days. It extends over a total of 7 month. In addition, we offer a two hour online Q&A session open to all participants with our trainer Achim Spengard to answer questions regarding the final exam.

To obtain the certification you have to pass a written exam. (180 min, open questions and answers)

The price is 7,900 Euro including registration (100 Euro) and examination fee (400 Euro). The amounts are VAT-free.
